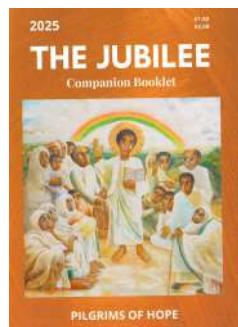

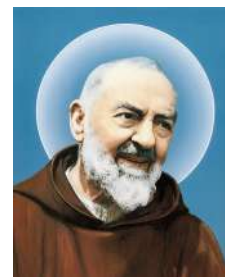
Isla Anderton, daughter of Thomas and Jill Anderton who was Baptised on 4 January at Our Lady and St Hubert's Church.

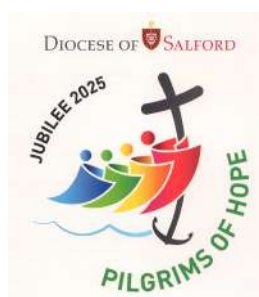


St Mary's 200 Club
