Stations of the Cross will take place every Tuesday and Friday during Lent, followed by Mass:

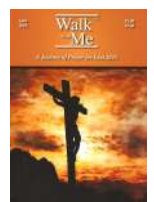

The candles in the system are completely smoke free, which will help preserve our statues and artefacts and reduce our maintenance costs.

The system does not use any plastic or aluminium. All the candle wax from the system is recycled.

The system is cleaner than our current votive system, and wax spillage on the floors, stands and surrounding areas will be greatly reduced.

The suggested donation is 50p per candle and we hope the beauty of the system enhances your experience of lighting votive candles.
