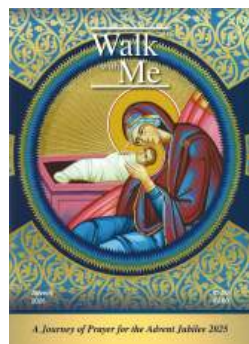

Luca Bear Dodgeon, son of Declan Dodgeon and Harriet Critchley, who was Baptised on 16 November at St Wulstan's Church.

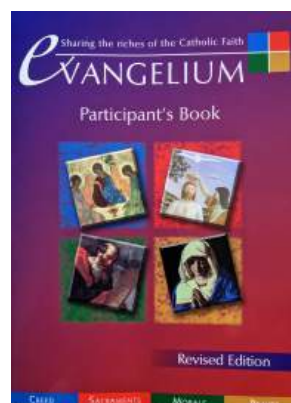
St Mary's 200 Club

The fifth draw of the Christmas 200 Club at St Mary's took place on Saturday evening. The winning number for the weekly £25 draw was 169.

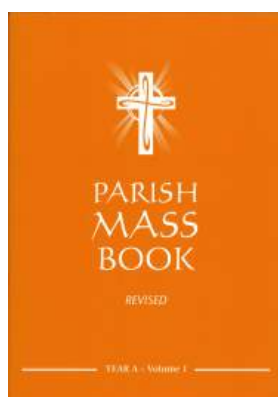
Interested in the Catholic Faith?
