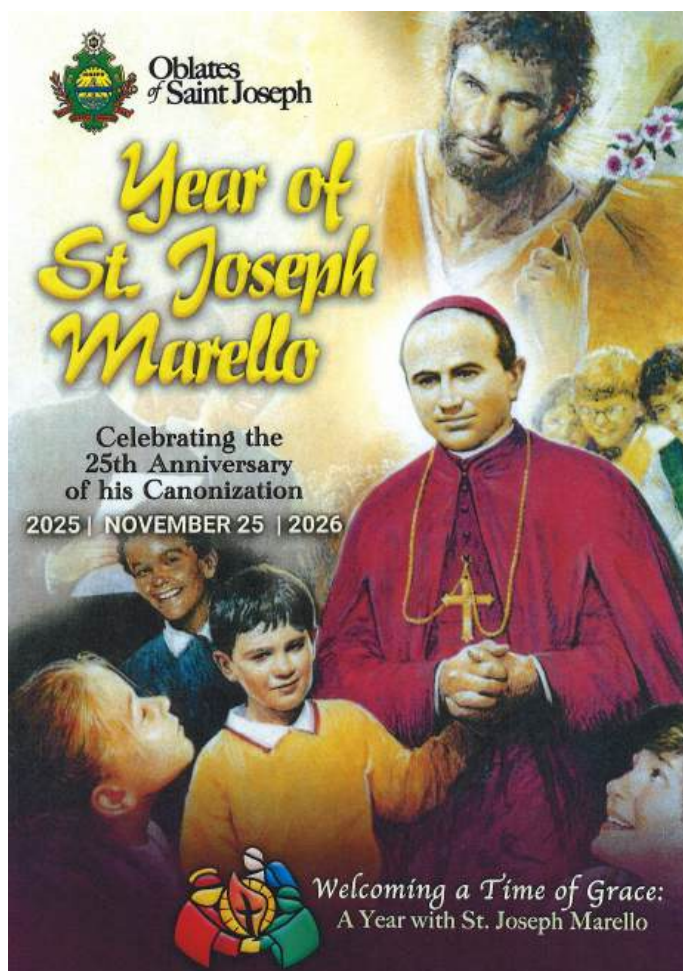
Feast of The Presentation of the Lord
