Polonia Northern England (PNE) Exiles and Descendants Exhibition

Discover the untold history of the deportation and exile of a large Roman Catholic community that resettled after the war in Northern England. Explore the groundbreaking exhibition at Manchester Central Library showcasing the experiences of the largely Roman Catholic community deported from Poland's Eastern Borderlands during World War II, their arduous journey across three continents, post-war lives in exile, and the legacy of their British-born descendants.

The display features archival materials, artefacts, and multimedia, highlighting resilience, contribution to the freedom of Britain and Europe, and the support of Polish missionaries who arrived to support the community to preserve their faith, culture, and identity when Poland was behind the Iron Curtain during the Cold War era.

Members of the parish of Our Lady and St Hubert's, who are also descendants of the post-war exiled community, are playing a key role in this pioneering project, to safeguard memories and develop PNE archives.

The first exhibition hosted by Manchester Central Library is open from 19 March - 30 June. PNE is also offering a platform for descendants of the exiled community to tell their story and is appealing for support to help build a collective memory of the post-war exiled community and descendants in Northern England.
