Collective Memory of the Polish House, Great Harwood

Polonia Northern England (PNE), the only charity dedicated to preserving the heritage of Britain's post-war Polish exiled community, is appealing for help to build a collective memory of the Polish House, Great Harwood, Lancashire - the former Allsprings Manor.

After the Second World War, Catholic Allied Polish combatants and their families found refuge here in Great Harwood as they were unable to return to their homeland, denied freedom behind the Iron Curtain under communist rule. Welcomed by the local community in Great Harwood, they remained here throughout the Cold War era, steadfast in faith, sustained by prayer and hope for a free independent Poland — a hope realised through the courage of the Solidarity movement and the spiritual witness and leadership of St John Paul II.

The charity is appealing to the wider British-Polish community in Great Harwood and surrounding areas for photographs, documents, maps, letters, memorabilia, oral histories and written recollections relating to the Polish House and Polish life in Great Harwood - including Polish House, local delicatessens, local services, contribution to local industry etc.

Sharing these precious memories, will help honour the sacrifice, faith and resilience of this generation and will help preserve this enduring British-Polish-Catholic legacy for those who follow. "Together, we can ensure their story continues to inspire future generations."
